

CW/VFM-76: Samuel A. Reed, 43rd Regiment of USC troops, Co. A

The 43rd Regiment of the USC was organized at Philadelphia in the early spring to early summer of 1864. It served in the major engagement of Petersburg (4/2/1865), and was present for Lee's surrender at Appomattox Court House. The entire regiment was mustered out by November 30th, 1865.

Discharge Paper:

Reed enrolled in the armed services on February 29th, 1864 and was discharged from service on October 20th, 1865 with the rank of corporal.
