

CW/VFM-113 (Oversize): 165th Pennsylvania Volunteer Regiment.

Descriptive book of the 165th Pennsylvania Volunteer Regiment. Includes a list of commissioned officers and a ledger of the men in the regiment. The ledger records the name, age, height, complexion, place of birth, occupation, enlistment information, and notes the individuals who deserted, were discharged, or died, and cause of death, where applicable. With the exception of Co. A of Franklin County and Co. B of Cumberland County the companies of this regiment were from Adams County.

Also included are 2pp. about the 165th Regiment from *History of the Pennsylvania Volunteers; Vol. IV* by Samuel P. Bates, and a printed list of the men of the unit.
