

CW/VFM-134: Glace, William H. 47th Pennsylvania Infantry, Co. F

A journal titled, "W. H. Glace's Memorandum & Scrap Book January 8, 1863."

Glace records an account of his daily activities, writing about the weather, when he is ill, when he has guard duty and the activities and men of his company. Several entries discuss Glace's travels for recruitment purposes, and there is also an account of his company responding to a ship in distress.

The journal also includes extensive notes, mainly about the history and geography of the state of Florida. There are lists of Florida's counties, important towns, and major exports, as well as a list of "Books useful in History of Florida". Also included are random notes, verses from poems and simple remedies. Several pages of the journal are left blank. AMsS-140pp.

Also included are 38pp of information about the 47th Pennsylvania Infantry, Co. F and its men.
