

CW/VFM-153: James Milliken

James Milliken enlisted in the 28th New York Volunteer Infantry on 4/30/1861 and was mustered into Company H on 5/22/1861. He took part in the Battle of Chancellorsville before being mustered out on 6/2/1863.

The 28th New York Volunteer Infantry was organized at Albany and mustered into service on 8/14/1862 for a two year enlistment. The regiment saw action at Cedar Mountain, Antietam, and Chancellorsville before being mustered out on 6/2/1863 at Albany.

James Milliken to Unnamed Recipient, 29 May, 1863

Milliken describes the regiment's participation in the Battle of Chancellorsville, emphasizing the confusion of the fighting and accusing the Confederates of not treating the Union wounded properly.
