

CW/VFM-156: Thomas H. Gibbons

Thomas H. Gibbons enlisted in the 62nd Ohio Volunteer Infantry in October of 1861. He would serve with the unit until he was transferred to Company I of the 67th Ohio on September 1, 1865.

The 62nd Ohio Volunteer Infantry was organized from September to December of 1861. The regiment took part in Butler's operations south of the James River in 1864, manned the lines at Petersburg, and participated in the final pursuit of the Army of Northern Virginia. It was consolidated with the 67th Ohio in September of 1865 before being mustered out on 12/71865.

The diary contains entries from the beginning of Gibbons' service in October of 1861 until July 1862.
